### **Transition**

the process or a period of changing from one state or condition to another.

### **Promenade Performance**

promenade performance, the audience moves to follow the performers around the space. Performances are often site-specific in interesting and unusual locations, even outdoors, rather than in purpose-built theatre spaces.
